Johnson Investment Counsel Recognizes Outstanding Students

Nicole Moulas is the daughter of Managing Director of Johnson Family Office Services, Dean Moulas and Catherine Moulas. She is in her Senior Year at the Ohio State University where she is majoring in Molecular Genetics.

Andrew Moulas is Dean and Catherine's younger son. He is beginning his Freshman Year at the Ohio State University majoring in Finance and Economics. He is a 2020 graduate of Anderson High School in Cincinnati, Ohio.

Johnson Investment Counsel established the Patrick Chong Memorial Scholarship in remembrance of Patrick Chong, a Portfolio Manager Assistant at JIC, who died of colon cancer in 2002 at the age of 31. In his memory, JIC annually awards two \$3,500 scholarships to children of Johnson Investment Counsel employees.

A committee of educators and administrators at the University of Cincinnati judges applicants on the basis of scholastic achievement, extra-curricular activities, community involvement, and proven potential in college curriculum. This is the first time in the history of the award that the two recipients have come from the same family.
